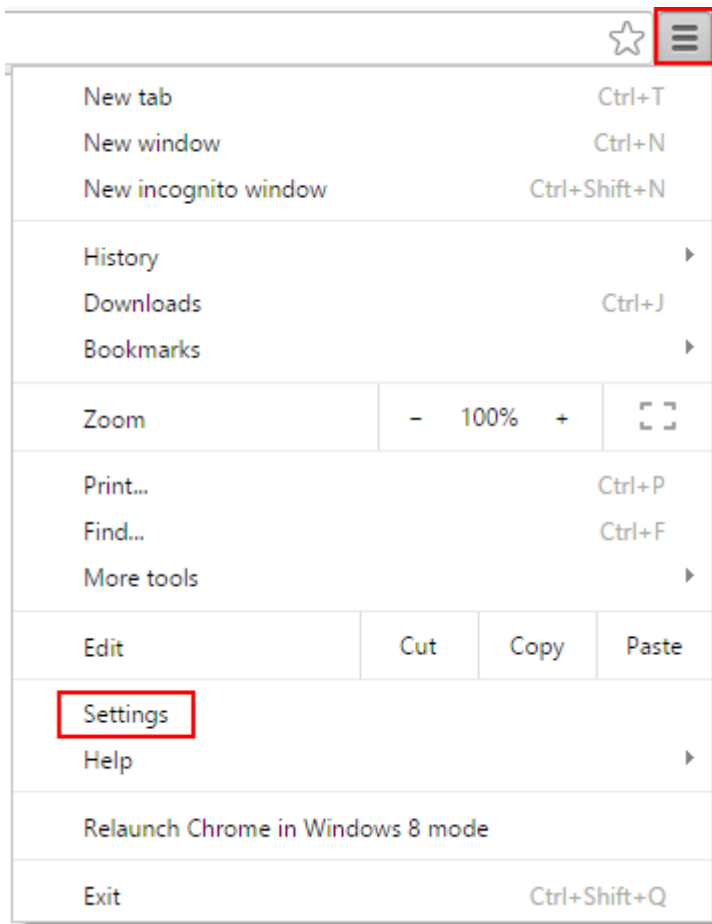


## How to view saved passwords in Chrome.

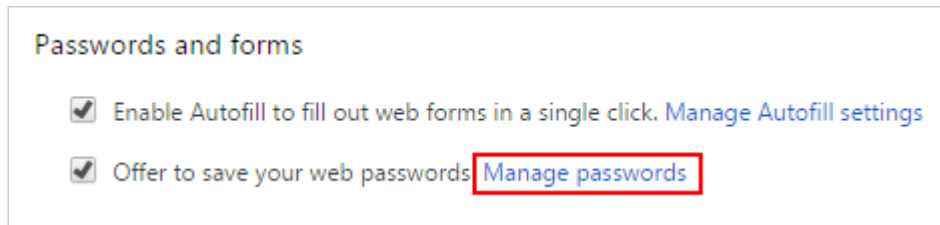

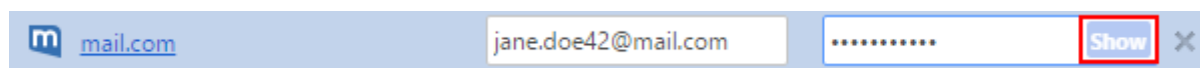
